<< Cristian Mihail Teodorescu (160 papers, about 3000 citations, Hirsch index 31) leads the Laboratory of Surfaces and Interfaces (22 people) from the National Institute of Materials Physics. The research activities are focused on atomically clean surfaces and well-defined interfaces, with a wealth of in situ structural, compositional, chemical, electric and magnetic characterizations: angle- and spin-resolved photoelectron spectroscopy, electron diffraction, scanning tunneling microscopy with atomic resolution, adsorption and desorption dynamics, band bending at interfaces, etc. These methods are implemented in several setups, all operating in ultrahigh vacuum: two complex clusters with photoelectron spectroscopy (including spin-resolved PES), molecular beam epitaxy and scanning tunneling microscopy, one X-ray photoelectron spectroscopy setup coupled to a high temperature / high pressure reaction cell, low energy electron and photoelectron microscopy (LEEM-PEEM), positron annihilation-induced Auger electron spectroscopy. During the last years, the group has obtained novel results at international level on chemistry and photochemistry at ferroelectric surfaces, graphene-based structures on ferroelectric surfaces, multiferroic structures, several epitaxial heterostructures, fundamental aspects of ferroic systems. The group publishes routinely in ISI ranked journals with high impact factor (5 to 12).>>

This includes synthesis and properties investigation of new mixed metal oxides, metal carbides, nitrides and oxynitrides and design of new approaches for the synthesis of organic-inorganic halide perovskite-type materials for photovoltaic applications.

Her research activities also focus on development of electrocatalysts for OER, HOR and ORR reactions and the use of 2D materials like graphenes and MXenes for catalytic applications, such as water splitting, chemoselective hydrogenation and selective oxidation reactions. >>

Her research interests focus on: (i) synthesis of novel heterocycles (*i.e.* 1,3,4-oxadiazoles, arylazopyrroles), their physical investigation and use in various applications; (ii) bioorganic chemistry – synthesis of probes for enzymes (*i.e.* peptide-based synthetic probes) and other biomolecules useful as tools for deciphering the biological world; (iii) supramolecular chemistry, with a particular interest in synthesis of dynamic macrocycles and discovery of novel molecules able to act as molecular switches, especially triggered by light (also called photoswitches). >>

Professor Carp is member of the Executive Committee and of the Academic Curriculum Group of the E.MA - European Master's Degree in Human Rights and Democratization, Venice, he is part of the research project *Ethics and Politics in the European Context* coordinated by the Catholic University of Lublin and member of the research network *Observatory on Local Autonomy* coordinated by the Université de Lille. He has a wide experience in teaching in different universities in Europe, Canada, USA, Argentina and Taiwan. 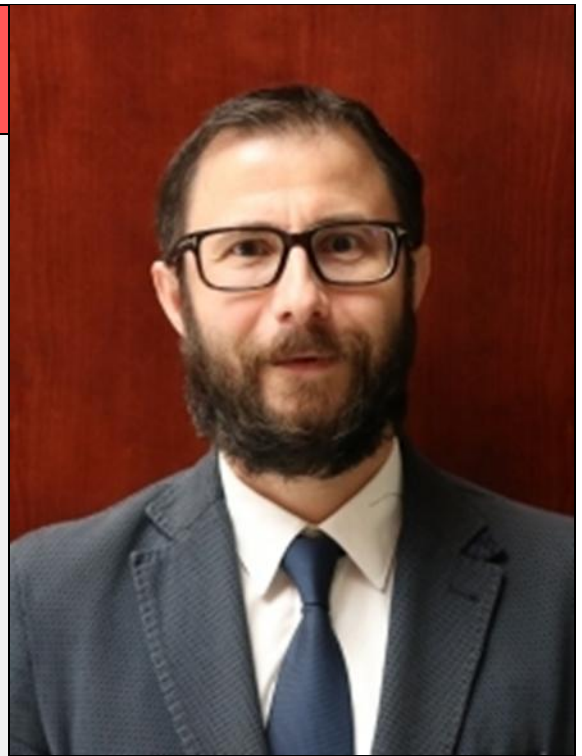

After serving as a Tutor and Assistant Professor at the University of Bucharest (2002-2008), I have been promoted to full-time teaching as a Lecturer in 2008 (Department of Orthodox Theology). Starting October 2018 I am serving as Academic Dean and Professor for Church History at St Vladimir's Orthodox Theological Seminary (New York). In terms of methodology, I follow an interdisciplinary philosophy by combining concepts and examples drawn from several disciplines (e.g. History, Theology, Classical Studies, Social Anthropology, and Cultural Studies). The laboratory in which new research ideas are forged and, in the same time, converted into something meaningful for students is the classroom. My students have the opportunity to take charge and engage with the primary sources and secondary literature, and to enhance their visual understanding of the abstract historical topics under discussion. >>

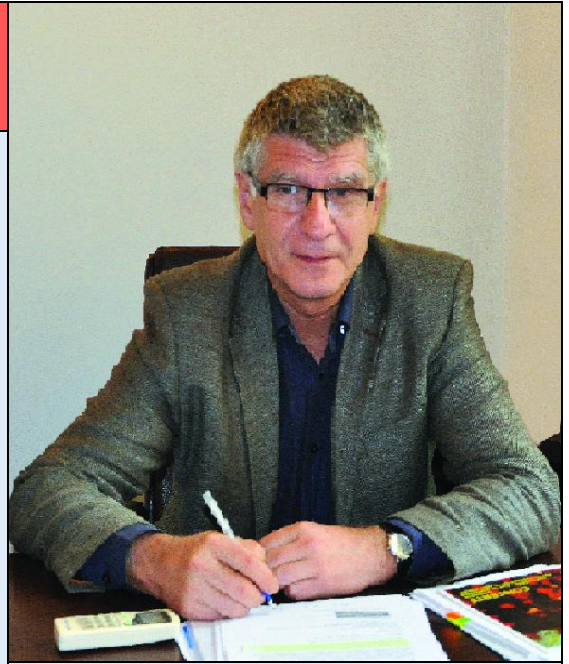

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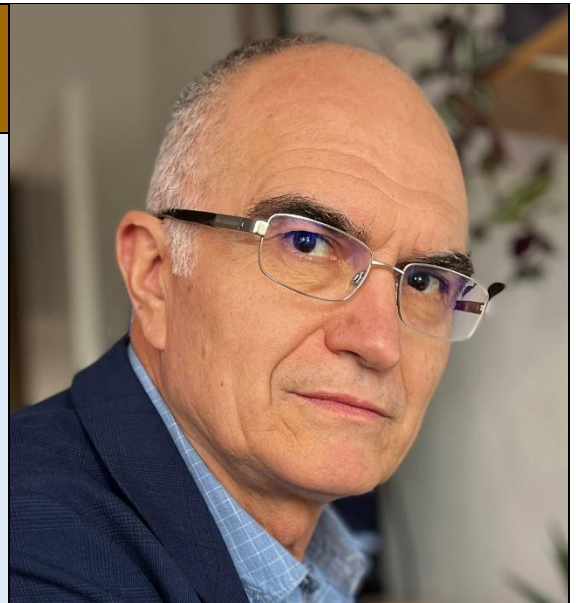
